Welcome TO DEENE PARK

Welcome to Deene Park, home of the Brudenell family since 1514. A largely sixteenth-century house incorporating a medieval manor with important Georgian additions. Deene Park was the seat of the Earls of Cardigan, most notably the 7th Earl who led the charge of the Light Brigade at Balaklava in 1854. The house today is the home of Robert & Charlotte Brudenell and their son William.

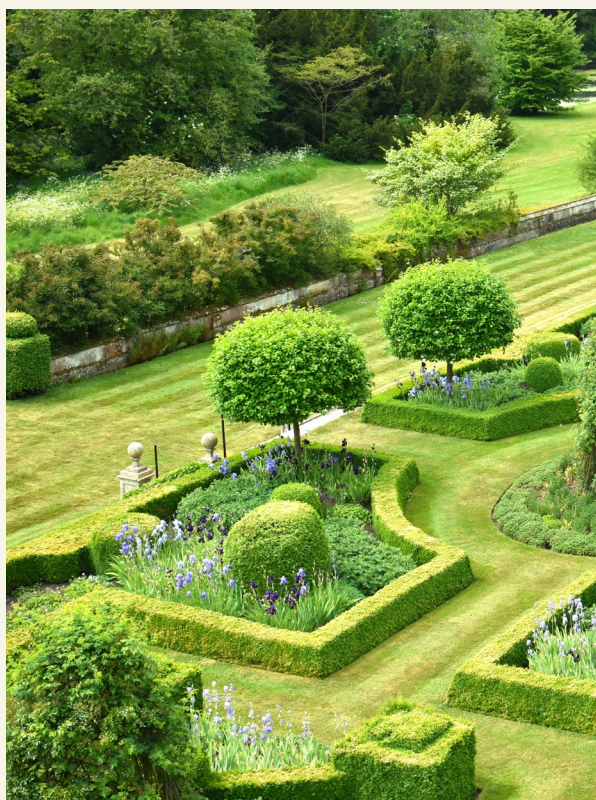

Deene Park is located off the A43 between Corby and Stamford, and is signposted from the main road.

For the North Gate please follow the road signs towards Deene Village, the brown road signs display a coach sign.

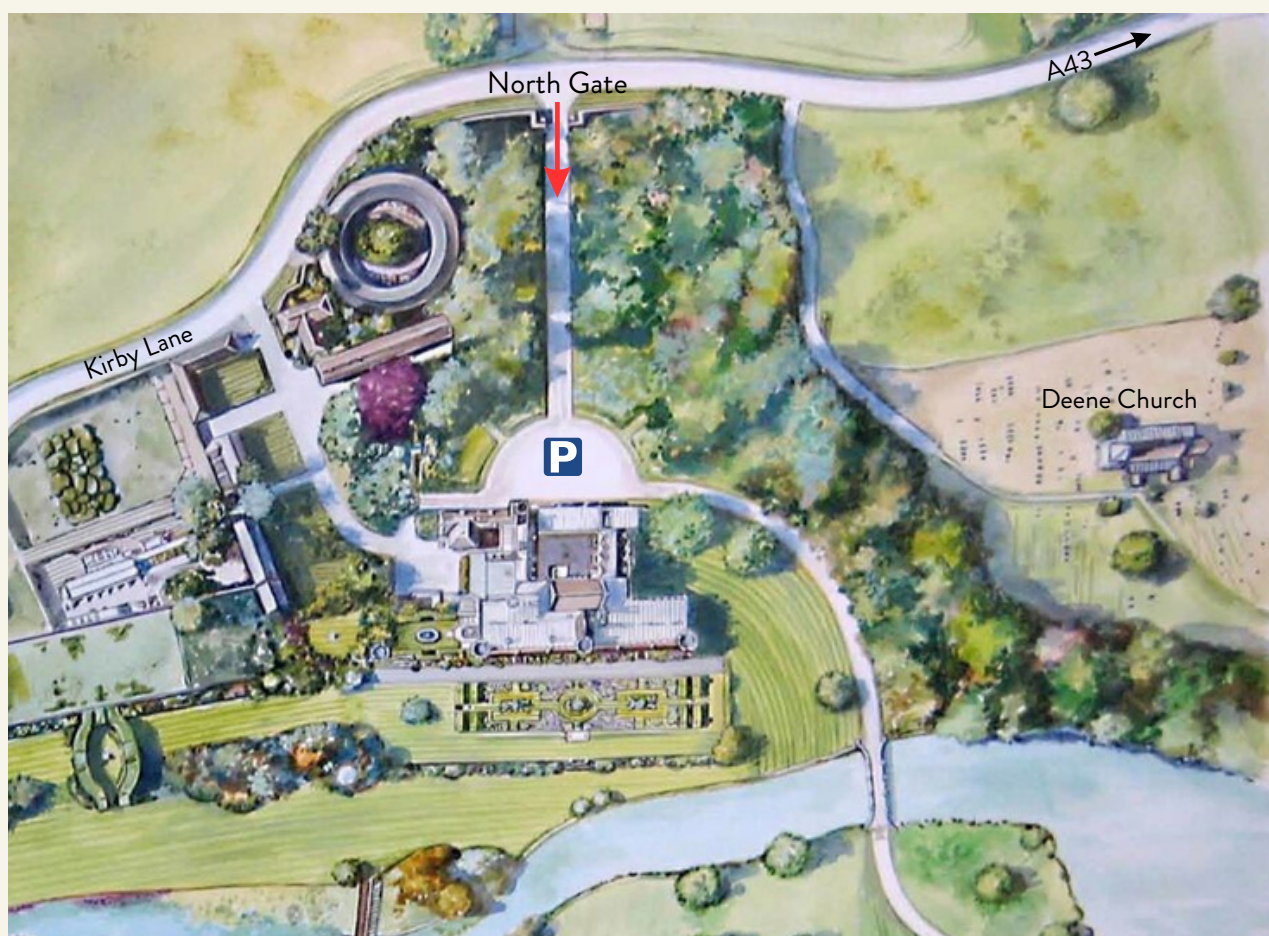

- Minimum group numbers: Private house tour - 20 people or a minimum charge of £400.00 (excluding catering).
Garden Tour - 15 people or a minimum charge of £225.00 (excluding catering).
- Maximum group numbers: Private house tour - 40 people. Garden Tour - 30 people.
- Please note offer cards or memberships (e.g. HHA, RHS) are not valid for private group bookings.
- As the tearoom is not open daily all catering must be pre-ordered, at least 14 days prior. We are unable to cater for requests on the day or operate the tea room on a free flow basis.
- The chosen option for catering must be the same for the whole of the group. Details of allergies or dietary requirements must be provided at least 14 days in advance.
- The Old Kitchen Tearoom can seat a maximum of 40 people at one time.
- All final details, including the final group number, menu choices and dietary requirements must be received no later than 14 days prior to the visit date. No reduction to the invoice will be made after this date.
- The remaining balance for admission and pre-ordered catering is due no later than 10 days prior to the visit date.
- Admission and catering charges for non-arrivals on the day of the visit are not eligible for a refund.
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the house or formal gardens.
- Photography is not allowed inside the house.
- Due to the size of the rooms visiting groups may be split into smaller parties for the house tour.
- Wheelchair users have access to the ground floor of the house. Please no motorised wheelchairs.
